Registration details	Are the YFVC registration details up to date; have you reported any changes to NaTHNaC?		
Annual return	Has the YFVC completed and submitted an <u>Annual Return</u> this year?		
Anaphylaxis and Resuscitation	Does the YFVC have a policy for anaphylaxis and resuscitation management? Are all health professionals (HP) responsible for administration of vaccines, up-to-date with resuscitation/anaphylaxis training?		
Cold chain	Does the YFVC have a policy for <u>cold chain and</u> <u>vaccine stock management</u> ? Does the YFVC have a vaccine fridge that meets the required standard for vaccine storage?		
Record keeping	Does the YFVC have systems in place to ensure records of vaccination will be maintained and archived according to national policy? Do the HP responsible for YF vaccine administration, know how to correctly complete and re-issue an International Certificate of Vaccination or Prophylaxis?		
Training	Have HP responsible for providing YF vaccine services, undertaken NaTHNaC <u>YF</u> <u>e-learning</u> (+/- virtual classroom)? Are HP aware of <u>precautions and</u> <u>contraindications</u> to YF vaccination? Are all staff aware of the YFVC <u>Conditions of</u> <u>Designation</u> , <u>Code of Practice</u> and <u>Commission</u> <u>on Human Medicines 2019 report</u> ?		
Clinical incidents / Adverse event Reporting	Do HP know how to report <u>serious adverse</u> <u>events</u> following the YF vaccine or inadvertent administration of YF vaccine (i.e. YF vaccine given where there was a contraindication)?
