
There will be no major changes to the website functions and the url (web page address) will stay the same.


You should notice clearer text and layouts, including changes to page section tabs and headings throughout the website.

Home page: You will see the tabs at the top of the page will have a minor name change to better reflect the content. 'Diseases in brief' changes to 'Topics in brief' and 'Factsheets from A-Z' changes to 'Factsheets & Resources'. We will also have the ability to include important news alerts at the top of the page when required and collect user feedback in a short online survey (this will appear at the bottom of the home page on occasions). There will new link through to information on our api and widget (more information on these features will follow in the near future).



Country Information pages

The country page index has had a minor design update and looks more modern. We also now have the ability to add an important alert box message on this index page. We might use this feature on occasions when we are in the process of updating multi-country pages, for example when the updated yellow fever certificate requirements have been announced by World Health Organization.

Within a country information page, you will notice the section tabs have been redesigned and now appear across the page. The 'Important news' tab has been renamed 'news'. The weather widget is back and where data is available, it will show the current temperature in the capital city.


